Music is an important part of liturgy. We encourage families to make full use of the Church's rich musical tradition and the parish's musical resources. Music for all liturgies is under the direction of the Pastor and the Director of Music Ministry.

Cantors & Soloists

We require that one of our skilled cantors lead the singing of the Hymns, Psalm, and the Eucharistic music. Additionally, if desired, the cantor may sing a solo during the Meditation following Communion. Our Pastor or Director of Music Ministry will be pleased to advise you on this.

Fees for Musicians

Organist - \$150-200

Cantor - \$150

These fees should be paid through the funeral home. If a funeral home is not going to be present at the Mass, a family member should pay the musicians directly on or before the day of the funeral.
